Joy South Africa Sponsors HIV / AIDS and TB Clinic

At a ceremony held earlier this summer, Joy South Africa contributed R486,077 (\$62,680 USD) to Alberton Methodist Care & Relief Enterprise (AMCARE). The donation will go towards the building of a comprehensive HIV / AIDS and Tuberculosis (TB) Clinic on its Alberton premises that will serve a population of over 1.5 million people in the area.



This clinic, a much-needed and easily accessible facility to the communities of the East Rand, will provide a facility for the treatment and medication of 2,000 to 3,000 HIV / AIDS and TB patients per month. It will be the largest faith-based initiative of its kind in the fight against these diseases in South Africa.

Kevin Brogan, Managing Director Joy South Africa, commented that Joy as a global organisation contributes substantially to local employment, training and skills development, and it is also important to participate in healthcare initiatives to help save lives, and create stability in local communities. Joy is extremely touched and honoured by the name of the clinic - Injabulo - which is the Zulu language word for 'joy'.

Deacon Dr. Vernon Van Wyk, Chairman of the AMCARE management committee, remarked that there are huge socio-economic problems in South Africa where we can make a difference in our community. This R1.5 million (\$194,144 USD) clinic is the culmination of effective partnerships between private sponsors, corporate donors and non-profit organizations to solve healthcare problems, specifically HIV / AIDS and TB. With Joy's generous donation the funds are now in place. Pending government sign-off for the medication, this 400 square metre (4305 square foot) wellness and Anti Rectorial Virus (ARV) dispensing clinic can be up and operational within six weeks.

Kevin Brogan further commented that socio-economic development is of fundamental importance to Joy Mining Machinery and the Black Economic Empowerment (BEE) department has set aside a budget to address issues of social concern. Joy fully embraces the principles of BEE as an exciting and challenging business opportunity to make a difference by empowering individuals and communities with the right to health and the opportunity to create wealth. The AMCARE clinic is one of the many projects that the BEE department has identified as part of Joy's social responsibility.
